The school is focused on delivering a suite of programs and initiatives that cater for individual differences so all students can experience success in a variety of ways and learn and achieve personal growth to equip them with the skills to thrive in a complex world.

Our values of Honesty, Respect and Tolerance are modelled and evident in all our interactions with students, parents, staff and community.

PHILOSOPHY:

Belle Vue Park PS's philosophy is to ensure that our students are championed to take risks with their learning, be independent, seek answers for themselves whilst being supported, nurtured and encouraged by their teachers

- encouraging comprehensive and meaningful partnerships between the school and our community; specifically, through strategic on-site services in our Community Hub programs which include Maternal Child Health nurses, play groups, 3 and 4 yr old Kindergarten program, first mother's group, RelateWell Counselling services & Allied Health services;
- Encourage and promote the importance of personal effort, showing initiative and caring for others;
- Building a sustainable learning culture focused on the right work to enhance student learning, as well as genuine commitment to the future direction of the school. This includes enhancing parental perceptions of the school; and



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• Ensure that all structures, processes, actions and behaviours are aligned with the school's vision, values of philosophy.
